AWARD FOR RESEARCH ON HERCULANEUM

The International Centre for the Study of Herculaneum, thanks to the generous support of the Friends of Herculaneum Society (www.herculaneum.ox.ac.uk), is once again able to offer an award for research to be carried out on a subject related to Herculaneum in 2009-2010. The award of £1,000 is intended to support travel to and time spent at the archaeological site of Herculaneum, Italy, and is open to students registered on a post-graduate university programme.

- Applicants must be enrolled at a university as a post-graduate student;
- The research carried out within this post-graduate course must be related to the archaeological site of Herculaneum;
- Fields of research include archaeology, ancient history, ancient art and architecture, conservation, heritage management, public archaeology, history of the discipline of archaeology, papyrology and other subjects specifically related to the study of Herculaneum;
- Preference will be given to candidates with Italian language skills.

The researcher receiving the award is expected to visit Herculaneum during 2009-2010, and to submit a written report on the results of their time spent in Herculaneum within a month of finishing their work on site. In addition the researcher is asked to submit a (hard or digital) copy of their final university thesis to the International Centre for the Study of Herculaneum.

How to apply

Applications will be considered on the basis of the following documents submitted by email to the International Centre for the Study of Herculaneum at centro@herculaneum.org by **15 October 2009**. The application should include:

- a completed application form;
- a curriculum vitae (maximum 3 pages);
- a short description of the applicant's university research, and how the time at Herculaneum would contribute to this research (maximum 1 page);
- at least one letter of support from the applicant's academic supervisor.

Incomplete forms will be given low priority. No application will be processed after the established deadline.
