

INTERNSHIP AGREEMENT



Article 1 - The present contract governs the relationship between the following two parties:

The Institut national du Patrimoine (Inp) a publicly administered entity supervised by the ministry in charge of culture, Galerie Colbert, 2 rue Vivienne, 75002 Paris - FRANCE Represented by **Mr. Charles Personnaz, Director** Party of the first part

and

The Parco Archeologico di Pompei Via Villa dei Misteri 2, 80045 Pompei - ITALY Represented by **Mr. Gabriel Zuchtriegel, General Director** Party of the second part

Concerning the training course attended by the trainee curator of the Institut national du patrimoine, civil servant trainee of the French ministry of Culture, named hereafter as:

Ms. Laëtitia DEUDON for the period of February 13 through March 31 2023 (included).

This training course, known as "internship abroad", is mandatory as part of education programme at the Institut national du patrimoine.

Article 2 - The purpose of this training course is to broaden the skills and professional horizons of future French civil servants, but also to establish links between heritage officers in different countries, thus preparing the groundwork for lasting future collaboration.

Article 3 - The Inp insures the trainee in all matters of civil responsibility concerning whatever damages she may cause during her training course (insurance policy number: MAIF, 1864130T).

Article 4 - The trainee retains the social protection she benefits from as part of her health insurance plan. The trainee is also covered in case of any work-related accident. In case of accident to the trainee on the job or traveling to or from the job, the training course leader commits to delivering all necessary statements as quickly as possible to the director of Studies in the Curators department of the Inp.

Article 5 - During the training course, the trainee is subject to the provisions of the host institution's internal rules, in particular concerning working hours. In case of a serious breach of discipline, the training course leader reserves the right to terminate the training course after having notified the director of the Institut national du patrimoine.

Article 6 - The trainee has the right to 1- day holiday during the training course.

Article 7 - The trainee retains her status as a trainee curator of the Institut national du patrimoine for the entire length of his course. The course is therefore not considered as a period of professional activity and does not give the right to remuneration from the host institution.

Article 8 - Expenses relating to food and lodging are not attributable to the host institution. On the other hand if the training course requires travel outside of the host city, the transport and lodging costs incurred shall be paid for by the host institution.
