Hereby declares

- that they have read the document “Guidelines for operations with Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems (RPAS) in archaeological areas” and that they will comply with the procedures for requesting access to the archaeological site for the performance of operations with RPAS, the restrictions that the RPAS Operator must comply with and the procedures indicated in the document;

- that they will comply with the ENAC Regulation 'Remotely Piloted Aircraft';
- that they have understood that operations can be conducted safely within the restrictions identified in the relevant Manuals;
- that they have installed the identification plate with the data required by the ENAC Regulation [Operator: Surname Name (if a natural person) or Organisation (if a legal entity), RPAS: Manufacturer/Type/APR construction number/SPR construction number];
- that they are aware that, in accordance with current legislation on the protection of personal data, the information contained in this declaration, as required by current provisions, is necessary for the purposes of the procedure covered by the declaration and will be used exclusively for that purpose, including with the aid of IT tools;
- that they are aware that this declaration shall lapse if the operations are not conducted in accordance with the regulations;
- that they are aware that, pursuant to Articles 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000, in the event of false declarations ascertained by the proceeding administration, the criminal penalties provided for will be applied.

To this end, the undersigned hereby confirms:

- that they are in possession of a Flight Manual or equivalent document;
- that they are in possession of an Operations Manual (not required for operations carried out with RPAs covered under Article 12);
- that they are in possession of a Maintenance Manual;
- that they shall operate the RPAS in accordance with the data contained in the relevant Manuals;
- that they have carried out a risk assessment to determine whether the operations are to be considered non-critical or critical as applicable (not required for operations carried out with RPAs covered under Article 12);

- that they completed the experimental activity preparatory to the specialised operations intended to be undertaken, as per the test report document;
- that they prepared an Operations Log in which the data of individual flights will be recorded, including: RPAS identifier, pilot name, date, take-off time, landing time, GPS coordinates of the ground station;
- that they have designated a qualified crew for the RPAs subject to this declaration, in possession of the certification required under ENAC Regulations (not required for operations carried out with RPAs covered under Article 12, paragraph 5)."

- that the pilot designated to carry out operations with RPAs under Article 12, paragraph 5 is aware of the Air Traffic Rules defined in Section V of the Regulations;
- that they the configuration document or equivalent document prepared by the manufacturer or design certificate as applicable.

Moreover, the undersigned hereby undertakes to:

- commence operations only after having received confirmation from the Park;
- allow Park staff to carry out any inspections and/or checks deemed necessary;
- keep all documentation mentioned in this Declaration at their own residence or registered office and make it available upon request by the Park for up to two years after the cessation of activities;
- give notice of any suspension/cessation of activities;
- give timely notice of any accident or serious incident that may occur, and of any modification to the system or to the terms of the declaration that may render it no longer valid;
- operate the system in meteorological conditions appropriate to the operations to be carried out, the characteristics of the RPA and the airspace concerned;
- operate the system in accordance with the air traffic and airspace usage rules contained in Section V;
- maintain the RPA system in a state of proper maintenance and airworthiness;
- take out adequate insurance in accordance with the procedures laid down in the Regulations prior to the commencement of flight operations;
- submit a request to ENAC for the use of airspace where necessary.
